

ORDINANCE NO. 1320

AN ORDINANCE ENACTED INCORPORATING THE
STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE BY REFERENCE

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING
BODY OF THE CITY OF WAKEFIELD, KANSAS:**

SECTION 1. Incorporating the Standard Traffic Ordinance. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Wakefield, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, 45th Edition, 2017, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. One official copy of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1320," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge, and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

SECTION 2. Traffic Infractions and Traffic Offenses.

- (a) An ordinance traffic infraction is a violation of any section of this ordinance that prescribes or requires the same behavior as that prescribed or required by a statutory provision that is classified as a traffic infraction by K.S.A. 8-2118.
- (b) All traffic violations which are included within this ordinance, and scheduled fine and court costs prior to the appearance date and that failure to pay the fine and court costs or appear at the specified time may result in the issuance of a warrant for the person's arrest. This information may be provided in a separate form if it is not provided in the notice to appear. The police officer must also provide the person with the address of the court to which the written entry of appearance, waiver of trial, plea of guilty or no contest and payment of fine and court costs shall be mailed.


SECTION 3. Repeal. Ordinance number 1314 is repealed.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be appended to the Ordinances for the City of Wakefield and this ordinance shall be filed with the City Clerk to be open for inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

SECTION 6. Any provision of this ordinance which shall be declared to be invalid shall not affect the validity and authority of any other sections of said ordinance.
