**ORDINANCE NO. 1308**

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE", 31<sup>st</sup> EDITION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES IN THE CITY OF WAKEFIELD, KANSAS; AMENDING SECTIONS 9-101 OF THE CODE OF SAID CITY AND REPEALING SAID EXISTING SECTION AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1299.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WAKEFIELD, KANSAS:

Section 1: That Section 9-101 of the Code of the City of Wakefield, Kansas, be, and is hereby repealed and the following is enacted in lieu thereof.

Section 2: That Section 9-101 of the Code of the City of Wakefield, Kansas be established to read as follows:

"9-101. UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE INCORPORATED. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating the public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Wakefield, Kansas, that certain code known as "Uniform Public Offense Code", 31<sup>st</sup> edition, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, in 2015 save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereinafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed. Not fewer than one (1) copy of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "OFFICIAL COPY AS INCORPORATED BY THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WAKEFIELD," with all the sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this section, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours."

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication once in the official city newspaper.
