

ORDINANCE NO. 1318

AN ORDINANCE ENACTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING NOMINATION PETITIONS FOR ELECTED OFFICE IN THE CITY OF WAKEFIELD, KANSAS

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING  
BODY OF THE CITY OF WAKEFIELD, KANSAS:**

SECTION 1. The City of Wakefield desires to adopt an ordinance establishing rules and regulations governing nomination petitions for elected office in the City.

SECTION 2. In accordance with K.S.A. 25-205, and amendments thereto, any person may become a candidate for city office elected at large by having had filed on their behalf, a nomination petition or a declaration of candidacy, accompanied by any fee required by law. The nomination petition must be signed by thirteen (13) of the qualified electors of the City of Wakefield.

SECTION 3. In order to sign or carry a petition under this ordinance, the bearer of the petition or any signatory must reside within the city limits of Wakefield, be registered to vote, and must be a member of the same political party as the candidate.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be appended to the Ordinances for the City of Wakefield and this ordinance shall be filed with the City Clerk to be open for inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

SECTION 6. Any provision of this ordinance which shall be declared to be invalid shall not affect the validity and authority of any other sections of said ordinance.
